


During this quarter, the ASAP Coalition disseminated 1,687 materials in the community. They gave 1 presentation(s) to 380 people.

In-kind resources are required by the DFC Grant at 100%.




This quarter, the ASAP Coalition generated \$11,924.71 in matching funds.
