Launched *Be A Parent, Not A Peer* Campaign

Partnered Anderson County Chamber on 6-County Legislative Agenda

Collaborated with County Commission to establish Pain Clinic Zoning Ordinance

Provided NAS Training to nurses and CME training on proper opioid prescribing to physicians

Established Anderson County Rx Task Force and organized to address prescription drug policy issues

Held Plant A Promise at high schools to pledge against tobacco use

Advocated for state law allowing local litigation tax, passed to allow local municipalities to fund prevention locally

Provided point-of-sale materials to alcohol outlets

Partnered with District Attorney's Office to send prom letter to parents

Underage Drinking Task Force held Town Hall Meeting

Partnered with local pizzerias to blast I Am One campaign on pizza box top coupons, on more than 30,000 pizza boxes

Partnered with school system to implement new student survey

Sustainability Committee became efficiently organized and raised \$8,562.72

Collaborated with County Commission to establish litigation tax to support local prevention efforts

Partnered with local florists to spread healthy prom messages to high school students

Generated over \$2,400 in revenue from business contributions

Received \$950 from Anderson County Beer Board; Generated \$1,577.50 in Responsible Alcohol Sales classes; Generated \$3,275 in Drug-Free Workplace Training classes

Successfully advocated for the continuation of the Tennessee Prescription Safety Act of 2014

Utilized funds from Kris Stults Memorial Fund to transport all 5<sup>th</sup> graders to Safe Kids Health Awareness Day at Smokies Park

Partnered with home health agencies to establish hospice medication disposal bags to be distributed to families

Collected 1,929.9 pounds of medicine through medication disposal program

Accumulated **1,457** collective volunteer hours from coalition members, valued at \$34,326.92!
