# Quarterly Report

## October—December, 2011

### PROGRAMMING

During this quarter, the staff and volunteers of Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention delivered 40 programs/trainings to a total of 819 people (Please see Appendix I for details) [+567% change from previous quarter in total presentations, +220% change from previous quarter in people reached / +1900% change from the same quarter of the previous year in total presentations, +525% change from the same quarter of the previous year in people reached]. In addition, 1 medicine collection event was held, netting 124 pounds of medicine. The permanent medicine disposal bin at CPD drew 5.5 pounds of medicine.

### MATERIALS

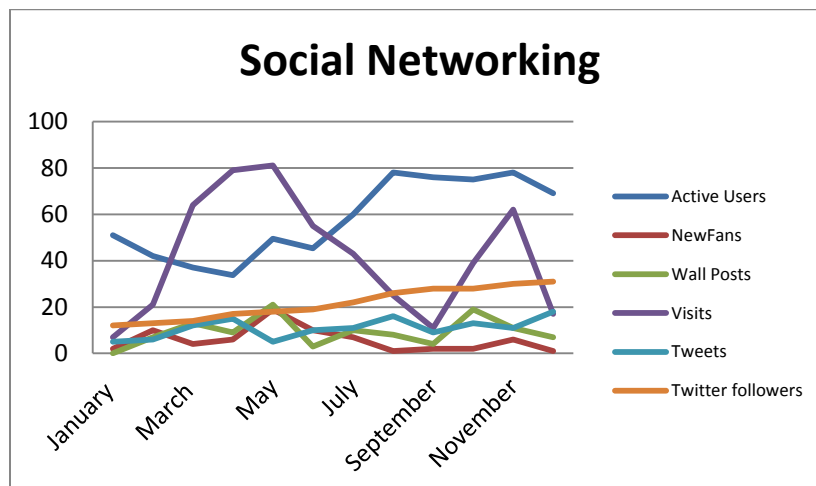
Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention disseminated 2,519 materials in the community. Beneficiaries of these materials were local civic groups, community agencies, and medicine collection participants (Please see Appendix II for details) [-75% change from previous quarter / +29% change from the same quarter of the previous year].

### RESOURCES (Cash and in-kind)

During this quarter, the staff and volunteers of Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention generated \$21,544.09 in matching funds [-69% change from previous quarter / +3% change from the same quarter of the previous year].

### SOCIAL NETWORKING

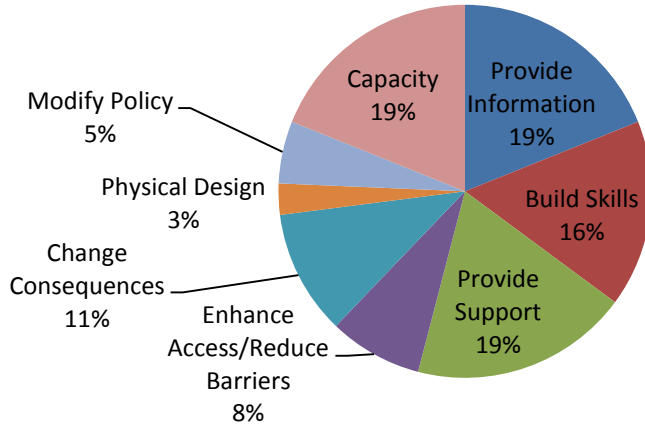

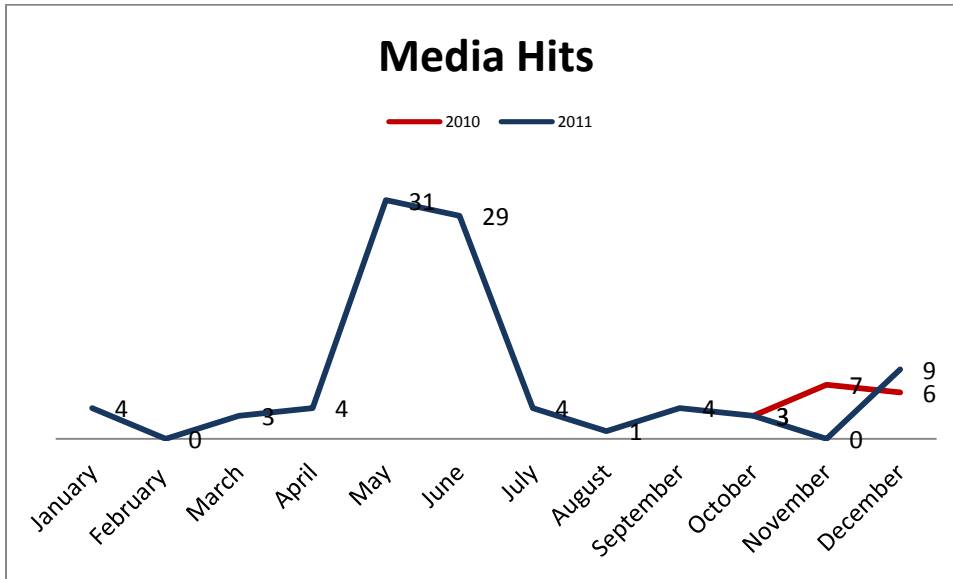
