
# Third Quarter Report



Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention (ASAP) of Anderson County is a private, non-profit organization whose mission is to engage community partners in the prevention of substance abuse in Anderson County through awareness, education, and policy change.

# **Quarterly Report** July—September, 2013

#### **PROGRAMMING**

During this quarter, the staff and volunteers of Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention delivered 7 programs/trainings to a total of 3,320 people (Please see Appendix I for details) [17% change from previous quarter in total presentations, 2396% change from previous quarter in people reached / -22% change from the same quarter of the previous year in total presentations, 1459% change from the same quarter of the previous year in people reached]. In addition, 2 medicine disposal events were held within the county, netting 191.4 pounds of medicine. The permanent medicine disposal bin at CPD collected 262.1 pounds of medicine. To date, the medicine collection program has collected a combined 3346.1 pounds.

### **MATERIALS**


Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention disseminated 4060 materials in the community during this quarter [825% change from previous quarter / 3201% change from the same quarter of the previous year].

During this quarter, the staff and volunteers of Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention generated \$27,459.48 in matching funds [-13% change from previous quarter / -24% change from the same quarter of the previous year].

#### SOCIAL NETWORKING




During this quarter, Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention utilized each of the following prevention strategies.
